20th November

7 in 10 carers start their caring journey in hospital. Carers have the rights in hospital but many do not know this.



Right to be involved

Carers can be involved in discharge planning with patient consent but also have a right to be consulted separately in relation to their own caring role.



Right to be identified

Carers have the right to be identified when they are caring for someone in hospital. This includes having their own hospital record recorded as a carer.



Right to be supported

Carers should be supported during the hospital stay and discharge process. Carers can be referred for this support via the QR code or URL.
